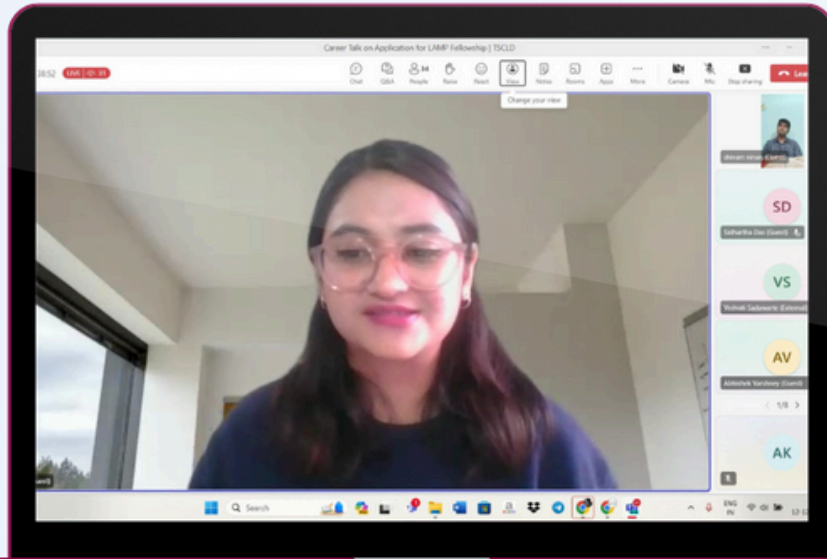
Ms Vibhuti Sharma provided valuable insights during the webinar. She stressed the importance of choosing a policy topic that aligns with one's comfort and interest. Vibhuti discussed the significance of clear communication in policy essays and walked the audience through the structure of a policy essay, emphasizing the need for coherence and well-researched narratives. Drawing from her experience as a Legislative Assistant, she highlighted key elements such as legislative intention, historical background, current bill analysis, and flaws and demerits in policy essays. Vibhuti also underlined the importance of backing arguments with evidence and offering recommendations for improvement.

Mr. Shivam Ninan shared his journey during the webinar. As a Legislative Assistant to Syed Nasir Hussain in the Rajya Sabha, Shivam discussed his responsibilities, including drafting parliamentary questions and contributing to the legislative process. He provided insights into the broader impact of the LAMP Fellowship, describing it as a

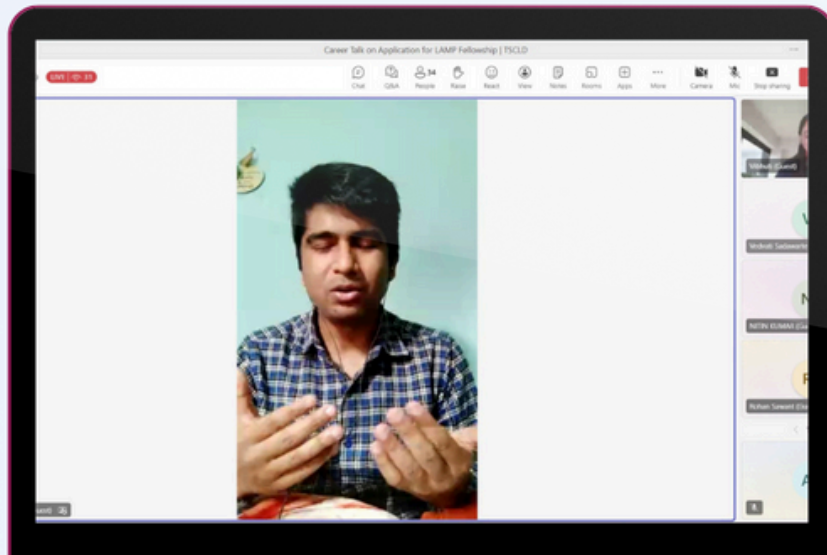
comprehensive learning experience in policy and governance. His talk reflected the versatility of skills developed through the fellowship, spanning both legal and corporate domains.
